From 100% indigenous Saperavi grapes. Deep garnet colour. Flavours and bouquet of wild berries and vanilla. Nice balance of brightness and silky tannins.

Winery:

"Alazani" winery is located in the very special place for Georgian winemaking history - village Kardenakhi where according to the legend every house, every door ("Kari") had a vine ("Venakhi") - "Kardenakhi".

The wine factory was the largest around the Caucasus region in 1970s. The company was rebuilt and restarted in 2016 with outmost respect to tradition.





Vinification:

The grapes are picked, carefully stacked in special wooden boxes, laid out on a special table and hand-selected one by one. Controlled temperature fermented. Aged in French oak barrels for 6 months.

Variety: Saperavi 100%

Residual sugar: 3 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 15°C. Goes well with moderately seasoned meat dishes, beef and chicken stews.
