Barolo DOCG 2016 Bera Azienda Agricola, Piedmont, Italy





An Elegant, austere, noble wine, obtained from Nebbiolo grapes, cultivated in the town of Castiglione Falletto, displays a garnet red colour with reflections warmer with the passing of time. In the glass it gives off ethereal and spicy fragrances, with light vanilla and flowery notes. A full bodied well balanced wine with a long finish.

Terroir:

Bera Azienda Agricola is located in the Langhe, on the right side of the river Tanaro, between Alba and Asti, surrounded by the villages of Barbaresco, Neive, Mango and Treiso in the village Neviglie. Vineyards cover a soft slopes hill with south-southwest orientation following the road from Neive to Neviglie. The soil is light-brown, rich in limestone and friable. A rather windy spot due to the conformation of the hills and the altitude varying from 320 to 380 meters a.s.l.





Vinification:

Handpicked and transported in small batches. Fermentation goes on for 2 weeks and the wine is aged for 2 years (1 in wood).

Variety: Nebbiolo 100%

Residual Sugar: 2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 17°C. It is excellent with stewed meat, game and aged cheese.
