Aromas of plum and red fruits, with soft and silky tannins. This wine shows the essence of the Douro region, with freshness and good acidity combined with red fruit and floral touches.

Terroir:

The Douro region is one of the world's oldest region for wine production. The "Alto Douro" Wine Region is part of a small elite classified as World Heritage by UNESCO. The village of "Casal de Loivos" is located at the sub-region of Cima-Corgo where the vineyards are planted in schist soil and arranged in terraces. 50 y.o. vineyars are protected by the Serra do Marão and Serra do Montemuro. There are hot summers and low annual precipitation.





Vinification:

Selection of the grape must and cooling at low temperatures. Fermentation in stainless steel vats, at 16°C for 20 days.

Varieties: Touriga Franca 35%, Tinta Barroca 35%, Tinta Roriz 30%

Residual sugar: 2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at ~17°C. Perfect accompaniment for red meat dishes, such as grilled or roast lamb, steaks and game. Try also with mushrooms and cooked vegies.
