

Terroir & History:

Winery was originally founded by French company Estansan in 1922. In 1940 local winegrower, Victor Henriquez Solar acquired the winery. Now the winery is fully modernised and has 320 Ha of vineyards in most important and oldest region, Maule Valley - southern Central Valley. The weather conditions of the plots vary greatly depending on proximity to the ocean or the Andes.



Vinification:

Hand-picked. Fermentation at ~25°C for ~7 days. Malolactic fermentation contact with oak. 60% of the wine aged in French (70%) & American (30%) oak for 6 months.

Variety: Syrah 100% Residual sugar: 5 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Decant and serve in a fine glass at 17°C with grilled veggies and meats, baked pork or aged cheese.
