Terroir:

Domaines Bouyer is a group of top estates totalling 18 Ha in Saint Emilion and Pomerol, including Château Milon Grand Cru, Clos de la Cure Grand Cru and Clos 56. A portion of the vines are situated on the Saint Christophe des Bardes plateau and the rest are situated on the plateau of Saint Etienne de Lisse, covering a total area of 7.5 hectares. The vineyard has clay topsoil over limestone sub-soil. Vines are 25-30 y.o.



Vinification:

Vinification in tank with punching down and ~3.5 week post-fermentation maceration in temperature controlled tanks. The wine was then matured ~15 months in barrel (50% new). Cellar potential up to 15 years.

Variety: Merlot 75%, Cabernet Franc 25%

Residual sugar: 2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Cellar up to a decade or decant and serve now in a fine big bowl glass on its own or with aged cheese, red game meats, grilled or in white sauces.
