Complex Armagnac from descendants of d'Artagnan

Each year the first of November marks the start of the distillation process of the grapes harvested on the 'Pasteur' plot that overlooks the lake at the Domaine d'Arton. Here lies the essential source of this magnificent Armagnac whose characteristics are so typical of this cool, limestone soil of the Haut Armagnac.

With its sumptuous topaz robe, hints of old gold and a brilliant and limpid aura, it has a nose that is very elegant lying atop base notes of fern. It is beautifully balanced in the mouth with notes of white flowers and a toasted aroma with a few hints of vanilla.

Terroir:

The Arton Domaine of 50 hectares lies on the plateau of Lectoure, in the heart of Gascony. The plateau is rich in limestone. This is what is called 'porous limestone' and also goes under the name of 'peyrusquet' (pocket of limestone rock), the ideal soil to grow mineral rich complex vines.



Variety: Ugni Blanc 100%

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Perfect accompaniment for smoked seafood, caviar, and Carpaccio. Try also with fruit dessert or ice cream.

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
