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Terroir:

The winery is located in Nava del Rey (Valladolid) municipality. The winery has 70 ha of vineyards total with Verdejo variety in Nava del Rei and Villaverde de Medina, DO Rueda, at 750m elevation. Continental climate with Atlantic winds. Soils are rocky, rich in calcium and magnesium.



Vinification:

Fermentation in stainless steel tank, slow and temperature <15°C. Tangential filtration.

Variety: Verdejo 100%

Residual sugar: 4 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 13°C with seafood, vegetables, white fish, poultry or roast veal.
