Terroir:

Lomond is situated on The Agulhas Plain near the southernmost tip of Africa at Cape Agulhas – the meeting place of the Indian and Atlantic Oceans. The vineyards are planted in the south facing blocks on the upper reaches of the farm within sight of the ocean whose cooling breezes results in late ripening intense fruit. The vineyards are planted on 18 different soil types, which appear naturally in small pockets and produce intriguingly complex wines with flavour profiles that differ markedly from one block to the next. Single Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc is one of the highest vineyards on the farm situated on the SE facing slopes of Ben Lomond, which ensures that the vineyard is cooled by the prevailing summer winds off of the sea.



Vinification:

Hand-picked. The juice was cold fermented at ~14°C. The wine was left on the lees for 8 weeks before being racked.

Variety: Sauvignon Blanc 100%

Residual Sugar: 2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 12°C. Excellent aperitif. Perfect accompaniment for artisanal pizza, cakes, pies, fish dishes or seafood.
