



## Gruner Veltliner Ried Schneiderberg 2017 Weinrieder, Niederösterreich, Austria

### Terroir:

The Weinrieder estate is situated in the centre of the Weinviertel region, the largest and most interesting wine growing area in Austria. Weingut Weinrieder own ~8 Ha extending from the best south and southwest facing sites, the Family Estate is growing Grüner Veltliner, Riesling, Weissburgunder, Chardonnay in the northern most winegrowing region. The single vineyards Birthal, Kugler, Schneiderberg, Hohenleiten, and Bockgärten have long become synonymous with highest quality. The predominately loess and loam soils impart minerality to compliment the characteristic “pepper” spiciness found throughout the region.



### Vinification:

Handpicked, careful de-stemming; the grapes were pressed gently and then fermented in cooled stainless steel tanks.

**Variety:** Grüner Veltliner 100%

**Residual sugar:** 3 g/L

**Serving suggestion and food pairing:** Serve well chilled at 9°C. Versatile! Perfect for grilled fish, “Wiener Schnitzel” and other deep-fried and grilled fare.
