Mukuzani, Perhaps the most famous red wine from Georgia, is named after the place of origin PDO Micro-Zone "Mukuzani" in Kakheti region. It is crafted from select Saperavi grapes and aged in oak barrels for 9 months. Black fruit and berries aromas are framed in gentle toast notes. Velvety tannins are crowned with long finish.

Teliani Valley has 120 hectares of vineyards in Kakheti. Kakheti viticulture history starts ~8000 years ago. Moderate humidity, with moderately cold winter and hot (often at 30-40°C) summer. Brown soils, also black and alluvial zones.



## Vinification:

Aged in oak barrels for 9 months.

Variety: Saperavi 100%

Residual Sugar: 2 g/L

**Serving suggestion and food pairing:** Serve at 18°C after decanting or cellar for ~10 years. Mukuzani is a great accompaniment to game meats, grilled steak, liver, lamb Mtsvadi (roast meat of lamb).
