

ISABELLA PURPURI 2020 PGI Vulcanesti Micro-Zone ICS DK- Intertrade, Moldova





Beautiful, shiny medium-bodied wine blended from the late harvest manually picked Isabella and Feteasca Neagra grapes. An impressive berry aroma and a pronounced strawberry tone. Natural sweetness is nicely balanced with zesty black berry notes in the aftertaste.

Terroir:

Founded in 1994, the company «DK-Intertrade» is a part «Dionis Club» holding, Russia. DK-Intertrade includes the AURVIN winery complex, the largest and most modern in Eastern Europe, which includes its own new vineyards, a grape processing plant and bottling of wine in the Vulcanesti region in the south of Moldova.

The Vulcanesti region is characterized by a hot and dry climate with the influence of the proximity of the Black Sea. Most of the vineyards are on limestone slopes providing good drainage.



Moldova is located on the same latitudes as Bordeaux and Champagne but its climate resembles Burgundy.

Vinification:

Cold slow fermentation result in fruitiness and freshness, saving the clean tone and all inherent antioxidants.

Varieties: Isabella 85%, Feteasca Neagra 15%

Residual sugar: 30 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 14°C. Perfect as an aperitif and digestive and/or with fusion, spicy, sweet and sour dishes. Also excels with freeze dried fruits and light desserts.
