Brick-red colour and a complex aroma of forest fruits, cranberries and dried plums with delicate sweet vanilla nuances. The fruit flavour surprises through its refinement, deepness and smoothness, ensuring a long lasting aftertaste.

In this red blend, Purcari hums a familiar Bordeaux tune in the key of Moldova. In any language, it's a symphony. Roşu de Purcari is a revelation of traditions: mature, rich and full of flavour.

Terroir:

Purcari Wineries Group is a leader in the wine and brandy segments in the Central and Eastern Europe region, managing 1,000 Ha of vineyards and 4 wineries in Romania and Moldova: Purcari, Crama Ceptura, Bostavan and Bardar.

The village of Purcari and the Agon Zograf Monastery vineyards lay at the heart of the special terroir. In 1827, Emperor of Russia Nicholas I issued a special decree granting Purcari the status of the first specialized winery in Bessarabia.

The "Ştefan Vodă" PGI region is one of the 4 wine-growing regions in Moldova, located in the S-E part with 4 districts – Căuşeni, Ştefan Vodă, Cimislia and Basarabeasca.



Vinification:

Handpicked, produced by the traditional method. Aged for 18 months in French oak.

Varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon 50%, Merlot 40%, Malbec 10%

Residual Sugar: 3.6 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Decant for 30 min and serve at 18°C. A great choice to serve with hot meat, like beefsteak, fillet, schnitzel, roast veal and grilled dishes.
