Terroir:

Marqués de Tomares is a family winery, whose beginnings date back to 1910. The winery is located in Fuenmayor – La Rioja, in the sub-zone of Rioja Alta. It has sunny skies, a warm climate, and complex patchwork of soil types. The foothills of a mountain range even protects the vines from blustery oceanic winds. For generations, the founding Families of Premium Fincas controlling over 300 small vineyards. The vines from which Gran Reserva blanco originates are oldest vineyards in Fuenmayor. Vines age ~100 y.o. Elevations up to 750m.





Vinification:

Fermented then aged over 3 y. in French oak barrels, then over 7 y. in the bottle.

Variety: Viura (Macabeu) 95%, Garnacha Blanca 5%

Residual sugar: 3 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 11°C. Great with toasty and smoky flavours, lightly seasoned poultry and pork and semi-hard cheeses.
