Deep dark purple colour with garnet hues with just a hint of carmine. Aromas of triple berry pie filling; blackberry, marionberry and dark cherry are teamed with a bouquet of soft creamy mocha that lift gracefully from the glass. Flavours reminiscent of a buttery black currant pastry are delivered by a wine with a smooth supple texture. The tannins are mature and feed a long finish with flavours of deeply toasted oak lingering well after the wine is gone.

Terroir:

The 2 Ha Dutchman vineyard is located at Stanislaus County, Central Valley of California. The Central Valley is running parallel with California's Pacific coastline. The hot, dry conditions which prevail here are conducive to high yields. The Central Valley producing more than half of the state's grapes.



Vinification:

Aged in 40% French Oak, 39% American Oak, 21% Neutral Oak

Variety: Petit Verdot 100%

Residual sugar: 2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 18°C. Perfect accompaniment for stewed red meat, fried liver, meat rolls, stew and vegetables. Can be savoured and enjoyed now.
