Deep ruby red characterizes our Zweigelt. In the nose the wine shows deep a fruit reminding of berries and cherries. On the palate the wine convinces with incredibly deep fruit together with fine spiciness. The medium bodied wine is supported by fine acidity and ends in a long and elegant finish.

History & Terroir:

Domaine Andau is the biggest and one of the most modern wineries in Burgenland. Andau community is made up of 90 families and started from 50 Ha in 1959. Today >600 Ha of vineyards in Neusiedlersee winegrowing region. Zweigelt grapes grow in selected vineyards in Andau, which are characterized by dry, gritty and mineral soils. This region is known to be one of the driest and hottest in Austria.



Vinification:

Handpicked in several harvests as the grapes ripen. Fermentation in stainless steel vats at ~29°C, finish in stainless steel and large wooden vats.

Variety: Zweigelt 100%

Residual sugar: 1.2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 16°C. Perfect accompaniment for pasta with meat sauce, risotto, pork and beef dishes or soft cheese.
