Armenian brandy, crafted from select indigenous Kangun and Rkatsiteli white grapes from the Ararat valley at 1,500m altitude. This brandy has a light amber colour and delicate taste with hints of vanilla and ripe fruits.

Terroir:

Armenia Wine Factory, a family winery planted its first vineyards in 2006 & the winery was founded in 2008 in Aragatsotn. The world's oldest wine cellar dating back 6,200 years was found nearby by archaeologists in Vayots Dzor, inside the Areni Cave. Continental climate. Vineyards are at an altitude of ~1500 m.





Vinification:

Hand harvested at beginning of September. After pressing, natural fermentation produces high-quality white wine, that undergoes double distillation. Brandy is aged in Caucasian oak barrels over 3 years.

Varieties: Kangun 80%, Rkatsiteli 20%

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve in a fine sniffer at room temperature with aged cheese, dark chocolate, nuts and dried fruits, or on ice, also great in cocktails.
