First born of the south of Lebanon. The white of the Vin du Marje is an explosion of aromas resulting in a peculiar mixture of Sauvignon Blanc, Viognier and Muscat Blanc à Petits Grains. It offers a balanced harmony of acidity and a strong and intense flavour that is delicate at the same time. Its yellow colour reflects the rays of the sun from the south of Lebanon where it originates.

Terroir:

Les Vignes Du Marje - new brand of wine launched in 2018. Located in the South of Lebanon, Jdeidet Marjeyoun is a town of warm and temperate climates. Winter months are rather rainy and cold and the summer months are warm and dry.



Vinification:

Hand harvested. Temperature controlled cold fermented.

Varieties: Viognier 65%, Sauvignon Blanc 30%, Muscat 5%

Residual sugar: 1 g/L


