Winery:

Rudolf Burschik who immigrated to Vienna from Franconia that founded the "First Austrian Vermouth Winery R. Burschik" in 1891. Southeast of Vienna in the area know as the Seewinkel, Burgenland there is a nature reserve that is one of the best wine-growing regions with unique microclimate.

The Vermouth herb characterizes the taste of vermouth and is responsible for its appetizing effect. Recipe contains 18 other herbs from the Alpine region, southern Europe and overseas.



Vinification:

Herbs extracted by hand, spices and citrus peels in blends of wine and alcohol that are matched to each other. When all the flavours are in perfect harmony, the base wines with the respective herbal extracts are blend.

Residual sugar: 100 g/L

Serving suggestion: Shining straw yellow, our slightly sweet "Klassik" asks to be paired with Prosecco or sparkling wine. Also great as a long drink with tart lemonades and juices. And of course pure on ice with lemon.
