Armenian brandy, crafted from select indigenous Kangun white grapes from the Ararat valley. Harmonious aroma of ripe fruits, spices, vanilla and nuts. Rich, round, elegant taste with sweet-spicy tones, a long and warm aftertaste with hints of dark chocolate, roasted coffee beans and oak.

Terroir:

Armenia Wine Factory, a family winery planted its first vineyards in 2006 & the winery was founded in 2008 in Aragatsotn. The world's oldest wine cellar dating back 6200 years was found by archaeologists in Vayots Dzor, inside the Areni Cave. Continental climate. Vineyards are at an altitude of ~1500 m.



Vinification:

Hand harvested at beginning of September. After pressing, natural fermentation produces high-quality white wine, which is necessary for further distillation of the brandy. Classic double distillation and aged in Caucasian oak barrels over 7 years.

Variety: Kangun 100%

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve in a fine sniffer at room temperature with aged cheese, dark chocolate, nuts and dried fruits, or on ice.
