"This wine with no added sulfur comes from vines planted in 1911. It is structured while also full of blackberry fruits. Ripe tannins complete a concentrated wine. Drink from 2023."

Score – 90p (Roger Voss, Wine Enthusiast, 2022)

A fruity, pure and mineral wine with violet floral notes, a hint of dark berry fruits (blackberries, redcurrant) and a black pepper finish, The tannins are well integrated on the palate with a balance on the fresh side.

Terroir:

The Château de la Terrière has stood in Cercié since the 16th century, in the heart of the Beaujolais region. It is one of the oldest estate in the region. 2 Ha of the vines are situated in the "La Siberie" lieu-dit, in decomposed pink granite soil with a mix of sand and stones.





Vinification:

Traditional whole bunch maceration for 25 days. **No added sulphite** during the vinification in line with the authenticity of the terroir.

Variety: Gamay 100%

Residual sugar: 0.9 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Decant ~1 hour and serve at 16°C with grilled red meat, game and Burgundy Chesses.
