The Grenache growing in our region is combining strength and softness. It expresses the land and the expertise of the winemakers. It is also one of the rare Lebanese terroir wines. A beautiful nose marked by white pepper and red berries. On the palate, its exceptionally round and elegant structure gives it an attractive balance with its light acidity. Make a date with this Grenache for a classy, voluptuous and enticing experience.

Terroir:

The vineyard, owned by the Chédid and Anid families, consists of 18,000 vines spread over 6+ Ha. It is planted in North Lebanon in the village of Eddé (Batroun region) at ~350 m elevation. It is one of the rare terroir wine produced in Lebanon. The clay and limestone soil and the microclimate of the Batroun region are ideal for nurturing quality wines.



Vinification:

Hand harvested. Whole grapes are de-stemmed and crushed, put in stainless steel vats, ~2.5 week alcoholic fermentation. Then pressing and malolactic fermentation. Aged 1 year for stainless steel. and cellared over 2 years in the bottle.

Variety: Grenache 100%

Residual sugar: 1 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 17°C. Perfect accompaniment for appetizer and light dishes, pizza, grilled fish.
