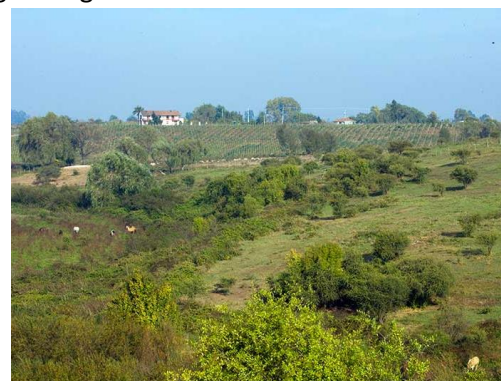

Terroir:

Viña I is a Boutique family owned winery, with vineyards located in the best terroirs in Chile. Irene Paiva Hantke, the winemaker and founder is famous winemaker and consultant in Chile, she thoroughly controls all the processes from the vineyard to the export as this is her own project.

The grapes come from vineyard "Armonia", located in Andes piedmont in Molina, Curico Valley. It has temperate Mediterranean climate and soils of volcanic and alluvial origin, influenced by the cool breezes running through the Rio Claro river.



Vinification:

Vinified in stainless steel tanks. Pre-fermentative cold maceration ~7 days. Inoculation with selected yeasts and controlled fermentation at ~27°C. Post-fermentative maceration ~5 days. Malolactic fermentation in barrels. Aged 14 month in 33% new French and American oak.

Variety: Petit verdot 100%

Residual Sugar: 3.4 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 17°C. Perfect accompaniment for spicy dishes, mature cheeses, pasta and grilled meats.
