A highly aromatic spirit distilled from white grapes wine and infused with Mediterranean herbs. Travarica is a true star amongst spirits. Its golden green hue, alluring fragrances and distinctive palate warm the hearts of true spirits connoisseurs.

History:

Badel 1862 is the largest and oldest wine and spirits producer in Croatia, continuing and cultivating the rich tradition inherited from the renowned companies Pokorny, Patria, Arko and Badel Vinoprodukt. Throughout its history Badel 1862 won numerous awards. The first one was obtained for Gorki Pelinkovac liqueur from Pokorny, the Silver Medal at the World's Fair, Paris, in 1867.



Vinification:

Produced by a unique combination of aromatic herbs and select wine distillate. Medicinal herbs such as Melisa, Salvia, Anise and Lavender are dominant in creating the outstanding flavour. Aromatic herbs are macerated and added to the high quality wine distillate. Demineralized water is added and Travarica is aged in the bottle. Travarica healing effect on our body is known for centuries.

Ingredients: Wine brandy from select Croatian grapes infused with macerated aromatic plants: melissae folia, anisi fructus, lavandulae flores.

Serving suggestion and food pairing:

Serve on ice before or after meal or with Mediterranean or Asian cuisine as best way to disclose the magic flavours of herbal infusions.
