Blend of three native varieties shows great charm, offering soft floral and lightly scented red-berry character with gentle spritz and refreshingly light, fruity finish. Very rich, intense, elegant and with a long aftertaste.

History & Terroir:

José Carlos Lima & Sons own the winery for over a decade, while respecting the traditional values and quality, they bring personal youthful touch to the exceptionally friendly wines they create.

Caves Campelo is one of the oldest Vinho Verde producers, it started in 1923 and officially was founded in 1951. Campelo group today has grown, it vinifies, bottles and distributes wines and brandy from several regions: Vinhos Verde, Douro, Dão and Port Wine.

Douro Region located in North-East Portugal, within the Douro River basin, is surrounded by craggy mountains. The soil is schistose with some granite. Marão and Montemuro mountains serve as barriers that protect the region from the humid west winds that blow in from the Atlantic. Winters are cold and summers are very hot and dry.



Vinification:

Grapes selection at the entrance of the cellar. Total stripping with cold pre-maceration (8°C) in stainless-steel tanks for 4 days (~25°C). Three “delastages” a day to extract soft and structuring tannins and previous pressing to keep black and blue fruity aromas. Ageing in stainless-steel vats

Varieties: Tinta Roriz 55%, Touriga Nacional 30%, Touriga Franca 15%

Residual sugar: 1.5 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Decant and serve at 18°C with cheese, lamb, rich meat meals.
