Pale pink colour with bright hues, a very appealing nose with hints of red berries and quince. Refreshing mouthfeel punctuated by a nicely balanced tingly acidity. Pleasant, fruity aftertaste.

Terroir:

Quinta da Lapa winery is over 300 y.o. located in the finest terroir amidst the rolling hills to the east of the Montejunto mountain in the highest part of the Tejo region, named after the great Tagus river, once known as Ribatejo.

72 Ha of vineyards are divided into plots and grape varieties.

Touriga Nacional: is one of the great national grapes, giving structured, aromatic wines, which may be kept.

Aragonês: Equivalent to the Tempranillo grape of Spain and Aragonês in southern Portugal. Rich in fruit, this is one of the first to present good levels of maturation.



Vinification:

Fermentation in stainless steel vats with temperature control.

Varieties: Touriga Nacional 50%, Aragonês 50%

Residual sugar: 2.89 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 12°C. Great pairing to Indian cuisine. It also goes well with tempura and other fish or vegetable fritters.
