Fruity Rotling, white and red grapes picked and then pressed together in a traditional way. Fruity note remains on the palate. Aromas of strawberry and raspberry.

History & Terroir:

Dating back to 1685, the Michel Winery is a family run business situated in the Nahe wine region (acknowledged wine growing area since 1971), situated in the Rhineland Palatinate. Viticulture here dates back to Ancient times. Characterized by abundance of sunshine, combined with modest precipitation and mild temperatures.

Grapes came from Sobernheimer Domberg vineyard. An interesting soil structure created during climate change from sub-tropical to desert like over 285 million years ago. Combined with river shingle deposited on river terraces during the formation of the Nahe Valley, 1.8 million years ago.



Vinification:

Red and white grapes pressed together, fermented in steel tanks.

Varieties: Müller-Thurgau 50%, Pinot-Noir 20%, Riesling 20%, Dornfelder 10%

Residual sugar: 17 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 11°C. Perfect accompaniment for BBQ, spicy and fusion cuisine or light desserts .
