The acidic structure is finely integrated into the wine's strong matrix. The colour captivates with its golden yellow colour. Aromas of ripe pears rise to the nose.

History & Terroir:

Dating back to 1685, the Michel Winery is a family run business situated in the Nahe wine region (acknowledged wine growing area since 1971), situated in the Rhineland Palatinate. Viticulture here dates back to Ancient times. Characterized by abundance of sunshine, combined with modest precipitation and mild temperatures.

Pinot Grigio came from Sobernheimer Domberg vineyard. This site, particularly in the middle of its slopes, is made up of both basalts, andesites or rhyolites of the late Perm era and dusty loams and loess typical for the younger ice age.



Vinification:

Fermented in steel tanks.

Variety: Pinot Gris 100%

Residual sugar: 4 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 11°C. Perfect accompaniment for seafood and pasta and variety of fish dishes.
