It has very lifted, fragrant nose of wild red berries, evergreen/juniper and floral. It is mid-weight, firm and juicy with great acidity and tension. The length is excellent."

Terroir:

Armenia Wine is a family winery that started in 2006 in Armavir, a region in the western part of Armenia, the heart of the Ararat plain between Mount Ararat and Mount Aragats. Dry continental climate.

Vineyards are at ~1000 m. altitude.



Vinification:

Hand harvested at end September - early October. 2 weeks of fermentation at the controlled temperature ~27°C in stainless steel tanks and 2 weeks of maceration.

Varieties: Areni 65%, Karmrahyut 35%

Residual sugar: 4 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 16°C. Ideal for meats and cheeses.
