Green glints. Notes of citrus (grapefruit), pear and white flowers. Fresh attack, nice length, soft acid of white flesh fruits.

Terroir:

The Dupuy vineyards occupy a 47 hectares surface which is composed of two châteaux: Beauséjour and Langlais. Located in the Saint-Émilion region, the town of Puisseguin produces only red wine. The terroir which is mainly limestone-clay soil is planted with three types of bordelais grapes. The non-use of chemicals goes back to 1947. The soils have never been treated with herbicides or insecticides.





Vinification:

Vinification in Thermo-regulated steel vats. Vatting time 1 month, handpicked.

Varieties: Sémillion 54%, Ugni Blanc 24%, Sauvignon Blanc 17%, Muscadelle 14%

Residual sugar: 2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 12°C. Ideal for the whole meal with country dishes, it is perfect to accompany rigatoni with meat sauce.
