This dry red wine made from Saperavi grape harvested in Mukuzani micro-zone is a top-rated Georgian wine. Wine has aroma traditional to this variety with notes of ripe cherry, almond and vanilla. Velvet taste of tannins’ is deliciously combined with notes of oak, with long finish.

History:

The story of the company begins in 1962, when one of the most powerful wine factories in the Soviet Union was launched – Tbilvino. For years the factory remained an essential part of the Soviet winemaking industry (90% of Georgian wines were made in this factory).

In the late 1990s it emerged as an independent wine company with new dynamic management, philosophy and approaches. Currently Tbilvino is again one of the largest, most awarded producers and exporters of high quality wines from Georgia.



Vinification:

The grapes are harvested until late October. Aged in oak barrels at least 3 years.

Varieties: Saperavi 100%

Residual Sugar: 5 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 16°C. Perfect accompaniment for cold boiled pork, sausages, lamb, venison, steak and aged cheeses.
