Tasting notes:

This light-bodied semi-sweet blueberry wine possesses a brilliant garnet colour, spicy and full-fruited bouquet, reflecting and distinct flavour of the honours the mighty wild blueberry. A true taste of Newfoundland young wine with an old Newfoundland recipe. Crafted from 100% blueberry, growing wild, pesticide and chemical-free in province.

Interesting fact about Winery:

Founded in 1993 Markland Cottage Winery, Rodrigues Winery located in Newfoundland Markland Cottage Hospital, which was built in 1935 and was one of 19 cottage hospitals built in Newfoundland and Labrador. Hospital was designated a Registered Heritage Structure by the Heritage Foundation of Newfoundland and Labrador in 2007. The building has been preserved as closely as possible to its original state. Pictures of the former staff and patients are on the walls, placards mark what each room was originally used for and pieces of original hospital equipment are on display. Many local people were born here and enjoy coming to visit their unique birthplace.





Vinification:

Hand crafted with care from best quality berries - wild and grown in a pesticide and pollution free environment. The water used in wine making is drawn from our own artisan well and has been tested for purity. Its quality is second to none. Product is created using minimal processing and have no added sulphites, artificial colours or flavours.

Variety: Fruit Wine, 100% Blueberry

Sugar: 23 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 11°C to accompany the spicy dishes, wild game, barbecued chicken, grilled fish, or with moderately sweet desserts.
