ALAZANI VALLEY WHITE, KAKHETI 2021

"Vaziani Company" LTD, Kakheti, Georgia



Semi dry white crafted from indigenous Rkatsiteli grapes grown in picturesque Alazani & Agrichay rivers valley, Kakheti, Eastern Georgia.

Ripe apple, quince, and melon aromas. Gentle natural sweetness of candied fruit, white flowers and apple jam followed by citrus finale.

History & Terroir:

Vaziani was founded in 1982 and modernized in 2012. Vaziani owns 120 Ha of vineyards in Kakheti, in the center of Telavi.

Peacock is the symbol of the winery. According to a legend, French writer Alexandre Dumas, compared the opening of the peacock's tail to the taste sensations of Georgian wine: "It opens up slowly and gently, you feel dazzling and pleasurable sensation and you want the feeling to last."



Vinification:

Handpicked late harvest. Softly de-stemmed grapes are cooled down to ~5°C and then gently pressed in the pneumatic press. Settled and clear juice starts fermenting slowly at precisely controlled temperature ~17°C in stainless steel tanks. Fermentation is stopped by cooling. Bottled in few months after the vintage.

Variety: Rkatsiteli 100%

Residual sugar: 33 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 12°C as an aperitif, accompaniment

to light desserts and spicy dishes.
