Alazani wine takes its name from Alazani River, which forms part of the Georgian border with Azerbaijan in eastern Georgia, before flowing into the Kura River. As a result of the slightly warmer climate in the Alazani Valley, the grapes that grow there are sweeter than elsewhere in Georgia.

Produced from indigenous Rkatsiteli Alazanis Valley White variety characterised by straw yellow, bright colour with golden hints. Clear and fresh with light acidity. Harmonious taste with notes of honey, duchesse and wildflowers. Velvety long aftertaste.

Terroir:

Eastern Georgia, Internal Kakheti, Kvareli district in the South Caucasus at 400-500 m altitude in the Duruji river valley at the foothills of pristine Caucasus mountains surrounded by nature reserves and National parks. Carbonate soils consisting mostly form the alluvial black-blue slate several meters deep.





Vinification:

The grapes are harvested by hand at the beginning of October. Controlled temperature fermentation at ~18°C.

Variety: Rkatsiteli 100%

Residual Sugar: 30 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 12°C with cold appetizers,

seafood, vegetable and fruit salads.
