Naturally semi sweet wine from ancient indigenous Saperavi grapes grown in Kvareli Region, Kakheti, Eastern Georgia. A bright bouquet with notes of ripe berries. Harmonious, extractive taste, fruity, with pleasant sweetness.

Winery and Brand:

Kartuli Vazi brand name translates as Georgian Vine.

Nekresi Monastery situated near the vineyards and depicted on the label is among the largest ancient monasteries in Georgia that was founded by St. Abibos Nekreseli, one of the famous Thirteen Assyrian Fathers.

Tifliski Vini Pogreb (Tiflis Wine Cellar) is one of the biggest wineries in Georgia, located in eastern part of the country, close by the famous Kakheti wine region.

Company culture is driven by responsible wine making that is based on long term partnership with local vine growers, control of harvest per hectare and sustainable approach toward the whole process.



Vinification:

Late harvest grapes are fermented in temperature-controlled tanks until desired residual sugar level is reached. Fermentation is stopped with chilling. Wine is kept in refrigerated tanks until bottling.

Variety: Saperavi 100%

Residual Sugar: 35 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at ~11°C on its own as an aperitif, try with Asian and Fusion cuisine, gourmet cheese and cured meat platters, and as an after meal treat.
