Appellation controlled red semi-sweet wine, produced from specially selected Saperavi grape grown in Kindzmarauli PDO Micro-Zone of Kakheti region.

Dark red colour. Strong varieties bouquet and aromas of cherry, blackberry, raspberry with tones of rose petals and crushed cherry pits. Velvety and rich taste, berry and fruity notes with delicate with natural sweetness.

History & Terroir:

Vaziani was founded in 1982 and modernized in 2012. Vaziani is the owner of 120 hectares of vineyards in Kakheti, in the center of Telavi.

Peacock is the symbol of the winery. According to a legend, French writer Alexandre Dumas, compared the opening of the peacock's tail to the taste sensations of Georgian wine: *"It opens up slowly and gently, you feel dazzling and pleasurable sensation and you want the feeling to last."*



Vinification:

Handpicked late harvest grapes. Macerated on skins for 8 hours. Fermentation at controlled temperature ~26°C in stainless steel tanks. After 5-7 days of maceration fermentation is stopped by cooling, to retain the natural sweetness and freshness of the wine. Wine is kept at ~0°C until bottling.

Variety: Saperavi 100%

Residual sugar: 35 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 14°C on its own or with sweet and sour or spicy dishes, dessert, dark chocolate, dried fruits and nuts.
