Terroir:

Vineyards are in the Central Valley of Chile. 122 hectares of vineyards located in the North in the Colchagua Valley. Warm temperate climate with a Mediterranean rain regime, very cool springs, very warm summers and mild winters; large temperature differences and constant afternoon breezes from the coast.

Soil: dark brown of alluvial origin, deep loam and sandy loam, with subsoil frequently mottled with more rocky and gravelly composition, including rounded rocks.

Harvest: Handpicked, with double selection in vineyard, during second half of April.

Vinification:

20-25 days with cold pre-fermentative maceration for 4 days at under 10°C. Extraction: Traditional pumping-over and punching. Fermentation with active dry yeast (Bayanus) at temperature ~27°C. Aging: 12 months in French and American oak barrels.

Variety: Cabernet Sauvignon 100%

Residual sugar: 4 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 16°C. Enjoy on its own or with rib eye steak and mushrooms.
