Plavac, one of the wines from the Peljesec palette of Plavac variety but it excels with its ruby red colour, developed varietal aroma and full yet harmonious taste with a slight sharp note.

Discreet note of dark red fruit jam such as plum or cherry & contributed with pleasant base of Mediterranean dried herbs. The flavour is medium strong body, enjoyable harmony with pronounced tannic structure which is characteristic for the variety.

Winery:

Badel 1862 is the largest and oldest wine and spirits producer in Croatia, continuing and cultivating the rich tradition inherited from the renowned companies Pokorny, Patria, Arko and Badel Vinoprodukt. Throughout its history Badel 1862 won numerous awards. The first one was obtained for Gorki Pelinkovac liqueur from Pokorny, the Silver Medal at the World's Fair, Paris, in 1867.





Vinification:

Plavac has been maturing from 1-2 years before bottling.

Variety: Plavac Mali 100%

Residual sugar: 1.8 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 18°C. Perfect accompaniment for the seafood specialties or roasted dark meat.
