The wine is light straw-colored with a greenish tint, characterized by an aroma of peach, pear, and wildflowers. It is well-balanced, with fresh acidity and pleasant minerality.

Terroir:

"Shumi" meant genuine, undiluted wine in ancient Georgian. It has long since been used as a defining term for the best wine. The logo of the winery is a griffin ("Phaskunji" in Georgian mythology), which, according to an ancient legend, brought the very first bunch of grapes to the people. Shumi has vineyards in micro-zones according to controlled designation of origin. Rkatsiteli grapes are grown in Kakheti in the Tsinandali Micro-Zone.

Vinification:

Indigenous Rkatsiteli Grapes are harvested by hand when sugar content reaches 21%. Fermentation is carried out in a stainless tank.

Variety: Rkatsiteli 100%

Residual sugar: 2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 10°C with white meats and seafood, mushroom, and pasta dishes.
