Vinification:

After two years of aging in oak barrels, aged in the bottle for at least three months.

Variety: Sangiovese 90%, Canaiolo 7%, Colorino 3%.

Sugar Content: 8 g/L

Food pairing:

It is a great complement to strong tasting poultry dishes, spiced lamb, grilled red meats, game and aged cheeses. It pairs well with tomato based sauces like marinara which makes this wine a perfect match for lasagna, Spaghetti Bolognese and pizzas.
