Intense, deep aroma, with a lovely trail of notes of raspberry, strawberry and fruit nuances. The wine has a rich, smooth taste, notes of ripe fruit in harmony with strong tones of red berries on a background of a balanced acidity. Sweet bouquet continues in a pleasant, long finish.

History and Terroir:

JSC Bagrationi 1882 is the first winery specialized in sparkling wine in Georgia, it was founded in 1937. The name of Bagrationi 1882 is connected to the name of Georgian Kings descendent Ivane Bagrationi - Mukhraneli, who started production of sparkling wines in Georgia using traditional method in the mid 19 century.

Bagrationi 1882 has vineyards in three regions of Georgia, this blend is created from the best grapes of two of these regions.

Tsitska grapes are sourced from the Imereti region in western Georgia that is known for its black soils.



Vinification:

Charmat Method. Fermented at a very low temperature with selected yeast strains to preserve the inherent fruit flavours. Second fermentation in pressure vessels.

Varieties: Chinebuli 33%, Mtsvane 32%, Tsitska 30%, Saperavi 5%

Residual sugar: 40 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 10°C. Perfect accompaniment for dessert, fruit, as well as appetizers with seafood and fish specialties.
