White-gold shiny colour, full of freshness remarkable lemony and metallic notes aromas, long lasting aftertaste.

Terroir:

80 Ha of vineyards are located at the slopes of Kithairona's Mountain in Central Greece, 60km west of Attica, at 450m altitude. Hot and dry summers give way to surprisingly cold winters with very little rain overall. Mild and cool winters and cool summers. Clay soil chalky substratum covered by a layer of stony clay allowing for drainage and soil heating.



Vinification:

Early morning harvest of mature grapes that are transported to winery in large cages. Vinification takes place in large stainless tanks at controlled temperature.

Variety: Assyrtiko 100%

Residual sugar: 1.8 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 10°C. Perfect accompaniment for white meat, seafood, pasta and hard cheeses.
