“Khvanchkara” PDO Micro-Zone

Most prized Georgian wine. Appellation controlled red semi-sweet wine from Racha region, Khvanchkara PDO Micro-Zone made from hand selected Alexandrouli and Mujuretuli grapes. Wine has complex elegant aroma with notes of raspberries and bilberries. Tender natural sweetness balanced off by clean acidity and velvety tannins in the finale.

Terroir:

The "Mildiani" was created in 1991 by brothers Mildiani in Tsinandali region. New modern wine cellar in the region of Gurdjaani was built and then expanded in ~2004, new vineyards were acquired in different zones of viticulture. Nowadays, winery owns 100 Ha of prime vineyards.

Khvanchkara micro-zone is located on the southern slope of the Lechkhumi mountain range (right bank of the River Rioni gorge) in Racha region. Small vineyards are planted on the elevation of 450-750m above sea level in the Rachuli Gorge.



Vinification:

Naturally grown and produced without use of chemical products. Fermentation at controlled temperature ~26°C in stainless steel tanks.

Variety: Alexandrouli 80%, Mujuretuli 20%

Residual Sugar: 4 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at ~14°C. Perfect for desserts, fruit assortment, cherry pie and jelly.
