Armenian brandy, crafted from select indigenous Kangun white grapes from the Ararat valley. Rich brown brandy colour plays a sunny golden hue. The aroma of brandy has rich woody and vanilla notes. Full, fascinating, rich flavour with obvious hints of chocolate and oak notes.

Terroir:

Armenia Wine Factory, a family winery planted its first vineyards in 2006 & the winery was founded in 2008 in Aragatsotn. Armenia is one of the oldest wine- and brandy-producing regions in the world, with a viticulture tradition dating back over 6,000 years. The world's oldest 6,200 y.o. wine cellar was found by archaeologists in Vayots Dzor, inside the Areni Cave.

Continental climate. High altitude Kangun vineyards at ~1,500 m elevation.



Vinification:

Hand harvested in small boxes. After pressing, natural fermentation produces high-quality white wine used for further distillation of the brandy. Classic double distillation and aged in French oak barrels over 3 years.

Varieties: Kangun 100%

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve in a fine sniffer with dry cured meats, cheese, chocolate and nuts.
