Dalmatian immortelle is the dominant ingredient of Korlat Travarica barrique, a flower that never withers, even when it is picked. Its opulence and characteristic Mediterranean scent are derived from the macerate of aromatic mint, sage, anise and basil rounded by Dalmatian immortelle. Slow maturation in Slavonian oak barrels brings out a recognisable taste worthy of a century long tradition.

About Winery:

Badel 1862 is the largest and oldest wine and spirits producer in Croatia, continuing and cultivating the rich tradition inherited from the renowned companies Pokorny, Patria, Arko and Badel Vinoprodukt. Throughout its history Badel 1862 won numerous awards. The first one was obtained for Gorki Pelinkovac liqueur from Pokorny, the Silver Medal at the World's Fair, Paris, in 1867.



Production:

Korlat Travarica Barrique is the supreme result of the centuries-old tradition of rakija production in Croatia. Slow maturation in Slavonian oak.

Serving tips: Serve on ice before or after meal or with Mediterranean or Asian cuisine as best way to disclose the magic flavours of herbal infusions.
