Select Saperavi sourced primarily in Kindzmarauli Micro-zone. The dark violet tinged wine has complex aroma, in which the tones of currants, black fruit and spices match harmoniously with the gentle tones of oak.

Terroir:

Vineyards are located in Kindzmarauli Micro-zone, Kvareli, Eastern Georgia, Internal Kakheti, where viticultural history started 7-8 thousand years ago. Vineyards are at 400-500 m altitude near the river. Carbonate alluvial soils are rich in the river brought black/blue slate (Kindzmarauli specific terroir). Climate is moderate warm with plenty of precipitation.

Saperavi, the most famous indigenous red Georgian variety, is also the darkest one (even the flesh is dark- Teinturier grape) and the hardiest one. It withstands well the mountain climate.



Vinification:

Once the grapes are ripe, the healthy bunches are selectively by hand at the end of September. Classic fermentation with must until complete fermentation followed by malolactic fermentation and refinement in 400 dal Caucasian oak barrels for 1-2 years.

Variety: Saperavi 100%.

Residual Sugar: 4 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Decant and serve at 18°C with meat, steaks, lamb, young cheeses, and pickled vegetables.



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
