Red, medium sweet wine produced from superior quality Eastern and Western Georgian Saperavi with an elegant touch of white Rkatsiteli from Kakheti region. This unique blend is crafted according to the ancient recipe using most advanced technology.

Wine has tender red berries aroma. In the mouth it displays a refined balance with the dominant tones of forest fruits followed by a gentle finale.

History:

The story of the company begins in 1962, when one of the most powerful wine factories in the Soviet Union was launched – Tbilvino. For years the factory remained an essential part of the Soviet winemaking industry (90% of Georgian wines were made in this factory).

In the late 1990s it emerged as an independent wine company with new dynamic management, philosophy and approaches. Currently Tbilvino is again one of the largest, most awarded producers and exporters of high quality wines from Georgia.







Vinification:

After 4 days on the skins, the wine is then pressed off and finishes its primary fermentation in temperature-controlled tanks at 26°C. Once desired residual sweetness is reached, the fermentation is stopped by chilling. Wine is stored in chilled tanks until final bottling. This results in fruity and lively character in the final wines. The vineyards are located in the Kakheti region of the eastern Georgia.

Varieties: Saperavi 70%, Rkatsiteli 30%

Residual Sugar: 34 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 9°C. Increasingly popular with variety of Asian and fusion cuisine dishes, fantastic with pork ribs. Makes a light and pleasant dessert. Excellent companion to cherry pie and fruit jelly.
