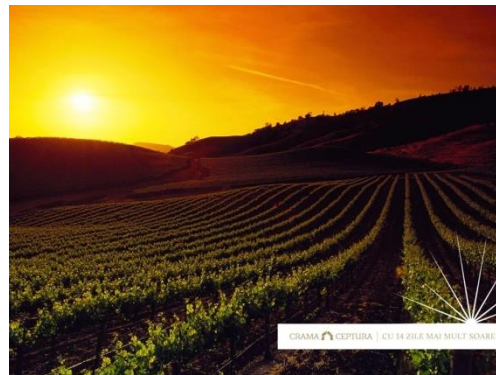

A red-garnet wine, intense, clear and luminous, with a complex taste suggesting the smell of dried plums, black currants and cinnamon. It has a rich, silky, corpulent taste, with soft tannins, impressive distinction and complexity.

Terroir:

Crama Ceptura is located at an altitude of 160 m in Ceptura Village, in the heart of the Dealu Mare wine region in Prahova County – one of the most famous viticulture areas in Romania. It is a place where nature gives more. Only here, in the commune of Ceptura, the sun generously bathes the land and the vineyards 14 days longer every year, making this region ideal for growing grapes.

This has perhaps inspired the legend of the noble Stag. Tempted by the warmth of this area, the stag, the king of the forest, often descends to Crama Ceptura vineyards.



Vinification:

Aged 6 months in French oak barrels.

Variety: Feteasca Neagra 100%

Residual sugar: 5 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 16°C, with venison, beef or mid ripen gourmet cheeses.
