Terroir:

The vineyards of Chateau Haut-Pougnan spread on the slopes of the right bank of the Garonne in the heart of the Entre-Deux-Mers in the Bordeaux. Calcareous clay soils help to create wines with subtle bouquet.



Variety: Sauvignon 60%, Sémillion 35%, Muscadelle 5%

Residual Sugar: 2 g/L
