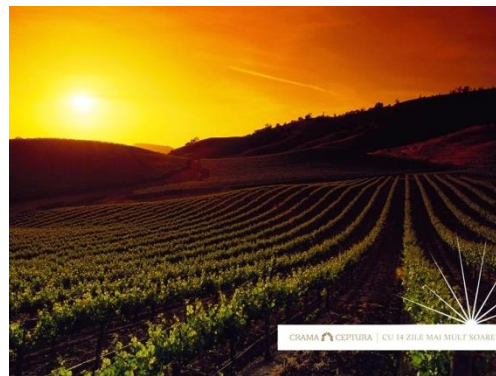

The complex black forest fruit aroma, the vegetal, grassy and elegantly rustic taste, slightly astringent indicates personality and terroir connection.

Terroir:

Crama Ceptura is located at an altitude of 160 m in Ceptura Village, in the heart of the Dealu Mare wine region in Prahova County – one of the most famous viticulture areas in Romania. There is a place where nature gives more. Only here, in the commune of Ceptura, the sun generously bathes the land and the vineyards 14 days longer every year, making this region ideal for growing noble grape varieties.

This has perhaps inspired the legend of the Noble as the Stag. Tempted by the warmth of this area, the stag, also called the king of the forest, often descends to Crama Ceptura vineyards.



Vinification:

Aged for minimum 6 months in French oak barrels.

Variety: Cabernet Sovignon 100%

Residual sugar: 3 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Serve at 16°C, with red meat and game dishes, rare grilled meats, fat goose, duck breast, lamb, pasta with tomato sauce, mussels, strong flavoured aged cheese or spiced vegetable salads.
