"The ample fruitiness of this 80% Merlot wine is right up front. It comes from a large 116-acre estate on the extension of the Pomerol plateau. Firm tannins as well as generous black plum and berry fruits are well balanced, just needing time to soften and fill out. Drink this full, rich wine from 2018."

Terroir:

The property dates back to 1832 for the Guichard family. The large, 36.5 hectare vineyard is planted to 75% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc and 5% Malbec. The terroir is gravel and clay soils that comes from 2 adjoining parcels. The vineyard is planted to a high, vine density of 7,100 vines per hectare.

Vinification:

Combination of concrete and stainless steel vats. The wine is aged in 20% new, French oak barrels for 15 months.

Variety: Merlot 80%, Cabernet Franc 15%, Malbec 5%

Residual sugar: 2.2 g/L

Serving suggestion and food pairing: Decant and serve at 16°C. Try with spicy, light meat dishes like duck, pork, veal or goat, excellent with mid ripen cheese.
